He has been an Air Force Chaplain, a founding member of Pittsburgh Lutheran Urban Ministries, Circuit Counselor in the Eastern District of the Lutheran Church, Pastoral Representative for the Lutheran Women's Missionary League, Board Member of the East Liberty Health Care Center, a member of the Lincoln-Lemington Community Collaborative and currently serves as a Hospice Chaplain with Heartland Hospice; and,
