**WHEREAS**, the Center for Urban Biblical Ministry is moving into its second 30 years with continued resolve to impact the Western Pennsylvania area for good as it continues to teach and train a new generation of students and leaders; and,

*WHEREAS*, on Saturday, January 20, 2018, the Center for Urban Biblical Ministry at Geneva College will kick off its next 30 years at its Alumni Brunch; and,
