WHEREAS, she is the co-founder of For Good PGH in 2016; a non-profit that develops and implements initiatives that promote diversity and inclusivity, and creates positive experiences for underserved populations in the greater Pittsburgh region; and,

WHEREAS, Kristen will be stepping down as the Executive Director of CONNECT at the end of this year to focus on the administration of her nonprofit initiatives. She currently resides in Edgewood with her husband, Greg, and her two children, Lucy and Romana; and

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Council of the City of Pittsburgh does hereby recognize the remarkable leadership by **Kristen Michaels** at the Congress of Neighboring Communities and commends and congratulates her for her vision, leadership, and commitment to the City of Pittsburgh and the region; and,
