WHEREAS, Ms. Lyda and Ms. Mico hail from Shadyside and Point Breeze, respectively, and are exceptional representatives of District 8; and,

WHEREAS, on 2018 and 2019 Ms. Lyda and Ms. Mico earned their medals in both the regional and national levels in the Women's Youth Lightweight Double; and,

WHEREAS Ms. Lyda and Ms. Mico became teammates in January 2018 where they would earn numerous medals together highlighted by earning a Gold Medal at the 2019 Midwest Regional Championship where they would go on to become national champions at the 2019 US Rowing Youth National Championship in the Women's Youth Lightweight Double; and,
