Resolution authorizing the Mayor and Director of the Department of City Planning to execute relevant agreements to receive grant funding from the Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Protection's DC Fast Charging and Hydrogen Fueling Grant Program to install electric vehicle charging stations in a parking lot at 6117 Kirkwood Street and further providing for an agreement and expenditures not to exceed TWO HUNDRED FOURTY FIVE THOUSAND SIX HUNDRED FIFTY (\$245,650.00) dollars for this stated purpose. The grant requires a match from the Pittsburgh Parking Authority in the amount of EIGHTY ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED EIGHTY THREE (\$81,883.00) dollars for this stated purpose for a total project cost of THREE HUNDRED TWENTY SEVEN THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED THIRTY THREE (\$327,533.00) dollars.

Be it resolved by the Council of the City of Pittsburgh as follows:

Section 1. The Mayor and the Director of the Department of City Planning of the City of Pittsburgh are authorized to execute relevant agreements with the Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Protection in order to receive a grant award in the amount of TWO HUNDRED FOURTY FIVE THOUSANDDD SIX HUNDRED FIFTY (\$245,650.00) dollars for the purpose of installing electric vehicle charging stations in a parking lot located at 6117 Kirkwood Street. The grant requires a match of EIGHTY ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED EIGHTY THREE (\$81,883.00) dollars from the Pittsburgh Parking Authority. Monies from the grant agreement shall be deposited into the Grants Trust Fund account 1129400290.45505.00.

Section 2. The Mayor and the Director of the Department of City Planning are further authorized to enter into Agreements, or Contracts, or utilize existing Agreements or Contracts not to exceed TWO HUNDRED FOURTY FIVE THOUSAND SIX HUNDRED FIFTY (\$245,650.00) dollars for the purpose of installing electric vehicle charging stations in a parking lot located at 6117 Kirkwood Street under the terms of the agreement between the City of Pittsburgh and the Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Protection. The grant requires a match of EIGHTY ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED EIGHTY THREE (\$81,883.00) dollars from the Pittsburgh Parking Authority for a total project cost of THREE HUNDRED TWENTY SEVEN THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED THIRTY THREE (\$327,533.00) dollars. Costs are chargeable to and payable from the Grants Trust Fund account 1129400290.50000.00.
