WHEREAS, **Diara Jackson** grew up in Penn Hills and attended Propel Braddock Hills, and as a 9th grader, makes A's and B's, takes higher math and will take 12th Grade AP Calculus as she dreams of becoming a Medical Scientist to help people using the power of science and math ; and,
