**WHEREAS, Olivia “Liv” Bennett**, member of the Allegheny County Council and beloved community activist, has been awarded the **Getting it Done Award** from **Run for Something** in recognition of her outstanding service to the people of Allegheny County; and,

**WHEREAS**, due to Councilwoman Bennett’s efforts, she won the Getting it Done Award from Run for Something, a national organization that encourages young and diverse people to run for office and become public servants, in a landslide, commanding over 40% of the vote; and
