Resolution authorizing, pursuant to Ch. 210 (“Acceptance of Gifts to City”) of the City Code, the Mayor and the Director of the Department of Public Works to accept a donation of six (6) safety ladders from Friends of the Riverfront valued at Twelve Thousand Forty dollars (\$12,040.00), to be installed along the southern shore of the Allegheny River from Rachel Carson Bridge to Point State Park at no cost to the City.

**WHEREAS**, a public safety concern exists along our riverfronts, especially along Allegheny Riverfront Park where fast moving water, heavy boat traffic, and high concrete walls make exiting the water nearly impossible; and

**WHEREAS**, Friends of the Riverfront have coordinated with the City to purchase six (6) safety ladders, funded by the Benter Foundation.

**Be it resolved by the Council of the City of Pittsburgh as follows:**

**Section 1.** Resolution authorizing, pursuant to Ch. 210 (“Acceptance of Gifts to City”) of the City Code, the Mayor and the Director of the Department of Public Works to accept a donation of six (6) safety ladders from Friends of the Riverfront valued at Twelve Thousand Forty dollars (\$12,040.00), to be installed along the southern shore of the Allegheny River from Rachel Carson Bridge to Point State Park at no cost to the City.

**Section 2.** The Department of Public Works will install and maintain these ladders on City property along the southern shore of the Allegheny River.
