Resolution providing for a Reimbursement Agreement or Agreements with the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation for costs associated with the Preliminary Design phase of the South Negley Avenue Bridge Project; providing for the payment of the costs thereof, not to exceed Three Hundred Seventy Thousand Dollars (\$370,000.00), reimbursable at ninety five percent; and the municipal share of Commonwealth Incurred Costs not to exceed One Thousand Two Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$1,250.00). Future Resolutions will authorize the project specific service agreements.

Be it resolved by the Council of the City of Pittsburgh as follows:

Section 1. The Mayor and the Director of the Department of Mobility and Infrastructure, on behalf of the City of Pittsburgh, are hereby authorized to enter into a Reimbursement Agreement or Agreements with the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation for costs associated with the Preliminary Design phase of the South Negley Avenue Bridge Project; providing for the payment of the costs thereof, not to exceed Three Hundred Seventy Thousand Dollars (\$370,000.00) to be paid from the following accounts:
